The first edition of the Triennial of Contemporary Art in Armenia, STANDART, will be held in Armenia from end July to end December. It is a periodic exhibition which will develop specific itineraries throughout Armenia based on a particular theme, once every three years, of the given exhibition.

The name of the Triennial is inspired by the avant-garde Armenian magazine Standard, published only once in 1924. STANDART highlights the rich cultural and historical context of Armenia. Through its itinerant character it involves wider and diverse communities and creates opportunities for dialogue and interactive relationship between artists, writers, curators, scientists, local communities, and visitors.

For the first edition the board of Armenian Arts Council has appointed as Chief Curator Adelina Cüberyán von Fürstenberg, Swiss citizen of Armenian origin. Adelina served as curator of the Golden Lion Award-winning National Pavilion of Armenia at the 56th edition of La Biennale di Venezia (2015), winner of the Swiss Grand Prix Meret Oppenheim (2016).

Le nom de la Triennale s'inspire de la revue d'avant-garde arménienne Standard, publiée une seule fois en 1924. L'événement souhaite souligner le riche contexte culturel et historique de l'Arménie, et vise à travers son caractère itinérant à toucher un public large et diversifié pour créer des dialogues et des relations interactives entre artistes, écrivains, commissaires d'exposition, communautés culturelles locales et visiteurs.

Pour sa première édition le comité du Armenian Art Council a désigné comme commissaire d'exposition la suisse d'origine arménienne, Adelina Cüberyán von Fürstenberg, Lion d'Or pour le Pavillon national de l'Arménie à la 56ème Biennale de Venise (2015) et lauréate du Swiss Grand Prix Meret Oppenheim (2016).

Inspired by the unfinished novel *The Mount Analogue*, by the French surrealist writer and poet René Daumal (1908 - 1944), STANDART 2017 will take place in various locations across the Mount Ararat region.

As a symbol of a poetic research and temporary experience, *The Mount Analogue* is a meditation on the pursuit of knowledge – based on the concept that the essence of a creative mind is directly related to who one is and what one experiences.

In the spirit of sustainable development and participation, STANDART, the Triennial of Contemporary Art, aims to build a bridge between the specific venues and the artworks presented and create an interactive dialogue

with the participating artists and curators coming from different backgrounds. It also seeks to develop exchanges and collaborations with Armenia's lively art and cultural scene.

The result of this art experience—placed within the context of some of the unique historic and cultural sites in the Mount Ararat region—will be a series of art exhibitions, encounters and direct collaborations, site-specific works and performances by the participating artists with Ministry of Culture of The Republic of Armenia artists living in Armenia. Finally, a book with artist contributions and texts by specialists from various fields offering a pluralistic approach to the theme of the *Mount Analogue* will be published in September.

Inspiré par le roman inachevé *Le Mont Analogue*, de l'écrivain et poète surréaliste français René Daumal (1908-1944), STANDART, se tiendra dans des sites historiques et culturels uniques dans la région du Mont Ararat (Yerevan, Sevan, Byurakan, Kapan and Gyumri).

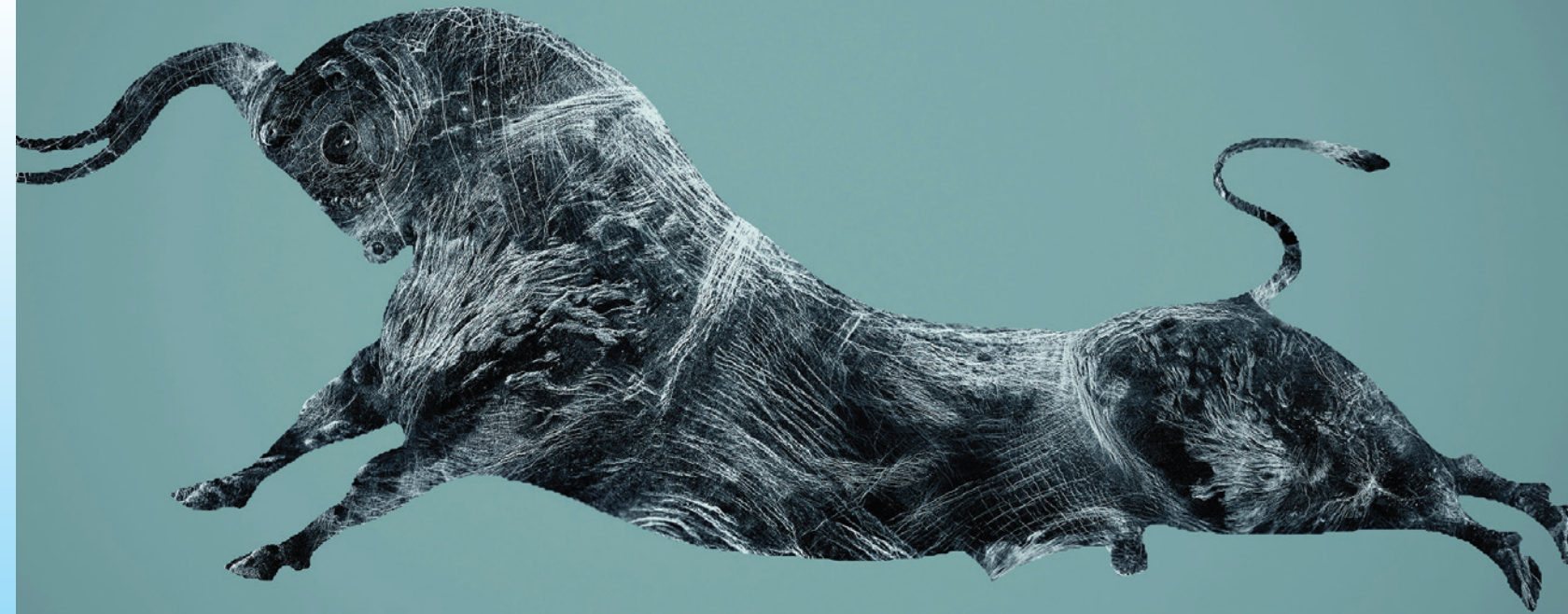
Symbole d'une recherche poétique et d'une expérience temporaire, *Le Mont Analogue* s'attache à la poursuite de la connaissance où l'essence de l'esprit créatif est directement liée à la nature et aux expériences de chacun.

Dans un esprit de développement durable et de participation, la Triennale d'art contemporain vise à construire

des ponts entre les lieux et les œuvres, créer un dialogue interactif entre les artistes venant d'horizons divers, et permettre des échanges et des collaborations avec l'art et la scène culturelle de l'Arménie.

Cette expérience artistique aboutira à une série d'expositions, de rencontres, de collaborations, d'œuvres in situ et de performances créées par les artistes participants et des artistes résidant en Arménie. En septembre, un livre sera publié avec les contributions des artistes et des textes de spécialistes de différents domaines proposant une approche plurielle du thème du *Mont Analogue*.

Embassy of Switzerland in Armenia

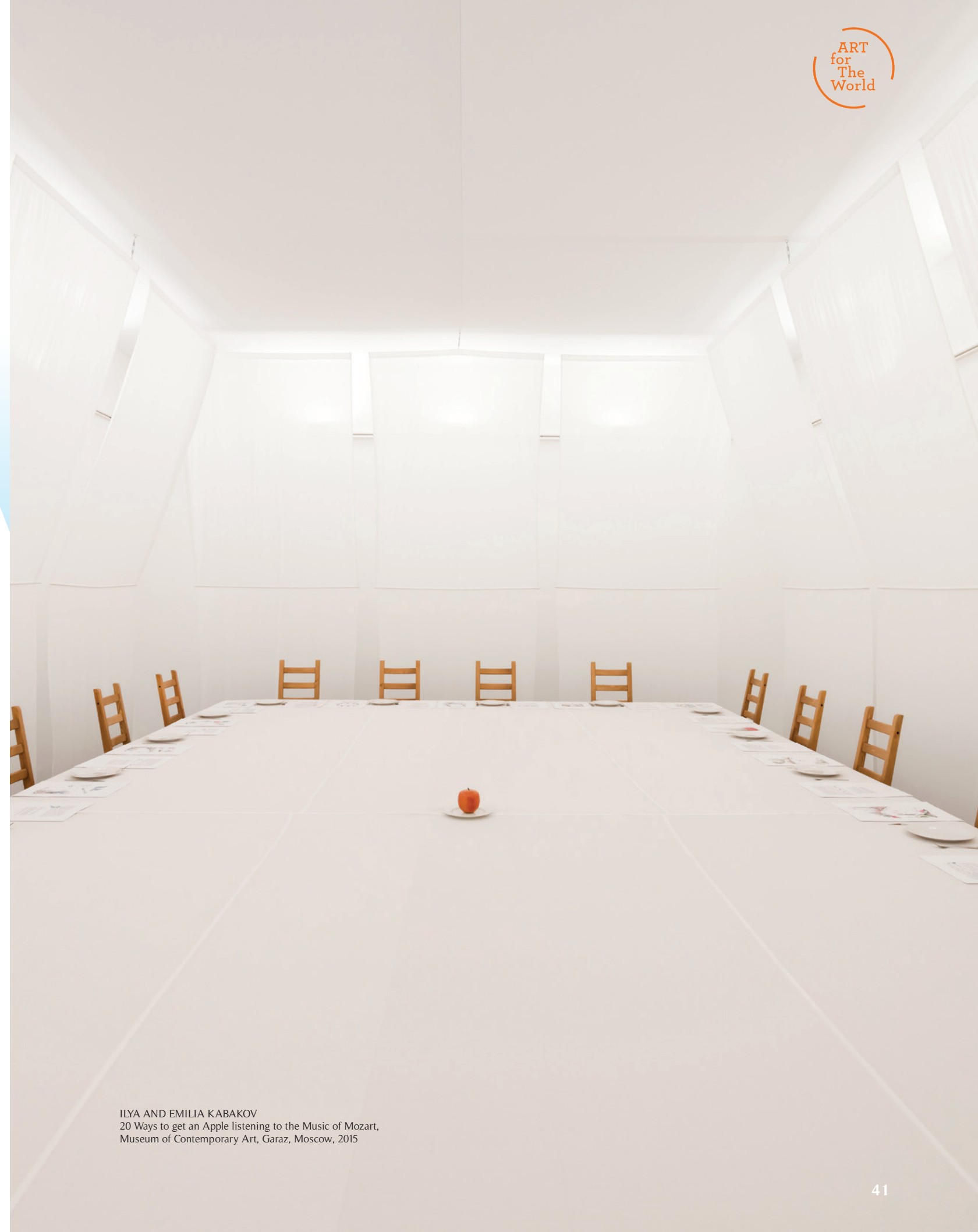
